- Works with Social Events Coordinator

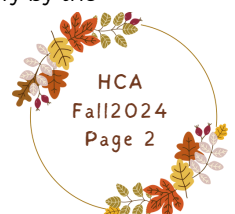
Soccer Coordinator 3 hours per month (more at season start)
