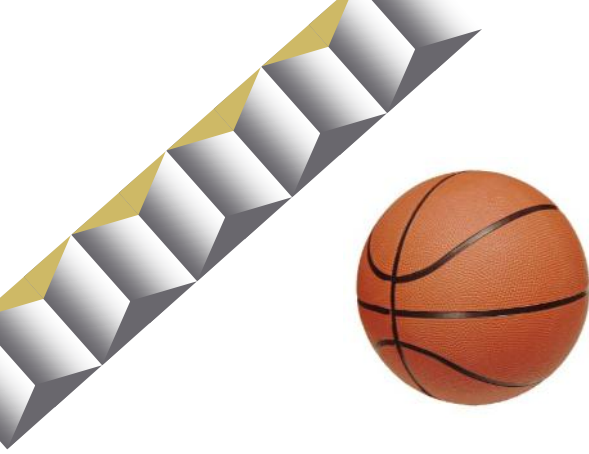

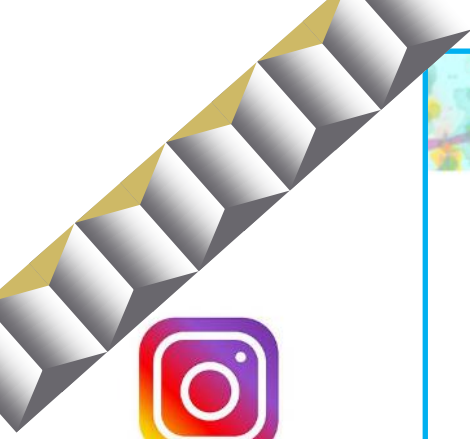

### Cosmo Collects Deposit Containers From Your Home

Cosmo Industries creates opportunities for adults with intellectual disabilities. In June of 2020 Cosmo Industries launched a new program, Cans4Cosmo, for residents interested in at-home collection of deposit containers. During a pandemic, and any other time actually, becoming a Cans4Cosmo subscriber is the best way to SKIP THE TRIP to return deposit containers to the bottle depot. So far Cosmo has collected from almost 900 households, including 24 in Holliston. Subscribers can choose a single 'purge' or continuing service where collections take place about every 10 weeks as that seems to be how long it takes for the average household to accumulate deposit containers. More frequent collections can be arranged for households who have beverage bottles, cans, jugs and cartons pile up at a faster rate.

A new subscriber is added to a route and will receive an email notification two days before the collection day and an email reminder is sent the day before. Donations are tracked and are eligible for a charitable tax deduction receipt which is distributed annually. Cans4Cosmo collects from every neighbourhood, every month. Cosmo is proud to provide this safe convenient service and appreciate the support of our neighbours in the community as we celebrate our 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
